Marc Carmichael, J.D., has worked in the field of charitable gift planning since 1976, and served as president of the R&R Newkirk Company, a leader in planned gift marketing, research and training, for 25 years. Marc has a bachelor's degree in journalism from Indiana University and is a graduate of the Indiana University School of Law. He is a past president and board member of the National Committee on Planned Giving (now the National Association of Gift Planners) and served on the board of directors of the Chicago Planned Giving Council. He has spoken at the national conferences of the National Association of Gift Planners, Association of Fundraising Professionals, National Catholic Development Council, American Council on Gift Annuities and the Association for Healthcare Philanthropy, and has chaired the National Conference on Planned Giving.
