Prior to her rejoining the Northwestern Medicine team, Julie was Executive Director for Planned and Major Gifts at the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago and Senior Regional Development Director for Conservation International, a US charity based in Arlington, Virginia that creates healthy sustainable economies and healthy communities around the world through the conservation of natural resources.

For fourteen years prior she served at Northwestern Memorial Foundation, the philanthropic arm for Northwestern Memorial Hospital in Chicago. For the last seven of those years, she served as the Planned Giving Director and earlier served in various roles including raising major gifts for clinical programs and managing the Benefactor Relations team.

Julie joined the Board of Directors for the Chicago Council of Planned Giving in 2007 and served as its President from 2011-2013. She currently chairs their Awards Committee. In the fall of 2009, she became active with the Evanston Community Foundation and joined the board in 2010. She co-chaired their 25th anniversary year in 2011 and two Celebrate!Evanston benefits and served on the Development and Responsive Grants Committees. She completed Leadership Evanston in 2011.
